Rules: The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing 2021-2024 (RRS), as modified by Appendix E – Radio Sailing Rules, the Equipment Rules of Sailing (ERS), the J Class Rules, and by the Sailing Instructions.

Eligibility: The regatta is open to all boats of the J Class whose owners are current members of AMYA (or their National Authority) and who are properly registered with the Class.

Racing format: The race committee shall attempt to sail 16 races each day. Three races are required to be completed to constitute a regatta. There will be a rescue boat on hand to assist boats.

Scoring: The regatta will be scored using Appendix A, Low Point Scoring system. If there are 1-5 races, no discards; 6-10 races, 1 discard; 11-15, 2 discards; 16 or more, 3 discards. This changes RRS A2.

Prizes: Trophies & AMYA red Chevrons will be awarded to the top three finishers in the regatta.

Measurements: Measurement and class authenticity verification may be conducted on site on a random basis as determined bythe Regatta Director.
